Students will develop and expand their skills learned and are given the opportunity to experience the responsibilities of a foreman on the building site. By the end of every second school year the building project is completed and will be sold by sealed bid.



The building trades class is designed to be a two-year course. Students will be responsible for the construction of a 1600-square-foot house on a job site away from the school campus. Each student will gain hands on experience on how to properly construct a frame dwelling. Skills learned include frame construction, roofing, selection of materials, layouts, working drawings, concrete forming, cabinet construction, interior painting and finishing, use and care of tools used in carpentry and cost estimates.
